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# ELIGIBILITY

Cedarhurst reserves the right to photograph works for publicity and educational purposes.

Only artists or craftspeople selling their own works will be eligible to participate. No dealers, agents or representatives will be permitted. All work must be original and creative. IDs will be checked upon arrival.

Kits, commercial molds or commercially fabricated forms are **not accepted**.

A jury will view the CD and make its selection based on originality, artistic conception and the quality of workmanship.

Only media accepted by the jurors will be permitted in booths. The committee reserves the right to view each booth after set-up and request that any work not meeting Cedarhurst standards be removed. Artists must bring sufficient crafts for both days. The Cedarhurst Craft Fair Committee urges exhibitors to demonstrate their crafts as much as possible.

This program is partially supported by a grant from the Illinois Arts Council, a state agency.

# APPLICATION DIRECTIONS

To apply for the 2010 Cedarhurst Craft Fair, complete the attached application and return with a \$25.00 non-refundable screening fee and four (4) images on a CD of your work, postmarked no later than March 15, 2010. Mark each CD with artist's name. If you want your CD returned, please enclose a self-addressed stamped CD ENVELOPE.

The CD will be the only criteria used. One image should show an overall view of the display. The other three (3) images should contain no more than three items per frame and be an accurate representation of all work to be exhibited. One image should be a close-up to illustrate detail. CDs will be returned, and notification of selection results will be mailed by April 15, 2010.

\* If you have more than one medium, you will need to have a separate application and fee for each.

## FEES

If you are accepted, a space fee of \$280.00\* will be due Cedarhurst Center for the Arts by May 15, 2010. Refunds will not be issued after July 1, 2010. There will be a \$25.00 processing fee on all refunds.

\* The \$5.00 increase in the booth fee will be used for the new "Peoples Choice Award" which will be announced at the Saturday evening awards banquet.

## BOOTH SPACES

Spaces are approximately 15'x10' in an open outside area. Exhibitors must furnish all set-up items. As the craft fair is outside, be prepared in the event of inclement weather.

**Electricity will be available to the first 60 registered crafters for an additional fee of \$25.00, and water will be available upon request.**
